#### REVIEW AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE POLICY

This item was reviewed by the Legal/Community Affairs Committee. District Counsel Murphy stated staff prepared, at the Board's direction, a proposed Electronic Signature Policy to implement the use of electronic signatures for the execution of agreements, letters, permits, and other internal or contractual records. Adoption of an Electronic Signature Policy would increase efficiency, particularly during the COVID-19 pandemic, by taking advantage of technological advances and state laws that allow for use of electronic signatures. California Government Code section 16.5 authorizes public entities to accept "digital signatures" if they comply with certain verification procedures and security standards. California Civil Code section 1633.1 *et seq.*, known as the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (UETA), allows for and sets forth standards that govern electronic records and electronic signatures.

The proposed policy prepared by staff provided that legislative documents, including District ordinances, resolutions, and minutes, would be included in the list of documents for which electronic signatures would be prohibited. This was based on the fact that state law does not address the use of electronic signatures for legislative documents, such as ordinances, resolutions, and minutes. Requiring "wet" signatures would be consistent with past practice and District record-keeping; the use of electronic signatures creates a lengthier public record due to the number of pages required to be attached for signature verification. However, as state law does not explicitly disallow the use of electronic signatures for legislative documents, the Board may direct staff to move these document types from the list of prohibited documents to permitted documents. Staff recommended the Board review and consider approval of the Electronic Signature Policy.

The Board directed staff to move District ordinances, resolutions, and minutes from the list of prohibited documents to permitted documents within the Policy.

DETERMINE THAT ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE SUPPLY AGREEMENT FOR THE STANDBY POWER GENERATION SYSTEM UPGRADE PROJECT ARE NON-RESPONSIVE, AND REJECT ALL BIDS; AND DIRECT DISTRICT STAFF TO NEGOTIATE A SUPPLY AGREEMENT, STARTING WITH APPARENT LOW BIDDER CUMMINS SALES AND SERVICE, OR ALTERNATIVE ACTION

This item was reviewed by the Engineering and Information Technology Committee. Technical Services Manager Ghossain stated the Supply Agreement for standby generator equipment for the Project was advertised for bids and the three bids received were opened August 6, 2020. The bid results were summarized in a table included in

the Board meeting packet. All bidders' submissions were non-responsive as they did not fully comply with the requirements included in the bid documents despite staff's efforts to obtain responsive bids. On August 13, 2020, the District received a bid protest from Peterson Power that identified commercial and technical requirements required by the bid documents that were not addressed in the bid proposals submitted by Cummins and Bay City. Staff notified both Cummins and Bay City of the required deadline to provide written responses to the protest. Cummins submitted a timely response, but it did not address all of the issues identified in the protest. Bay City did not submit a response. Staff and District Counsel reviewed the bids, Peterson Power's bid protest and Cummins' bid protest response and recommended the Board determine all bids to be non-responsive, reject all bids and proceed with one of two options outlined by staff in the Board meeting packet for this item. None of the bidders submitted any public comment on this item.

It was moved by Secretary Lathi, seconded by Director Kite, to Determine All Bids Received for the Supply Agreement for the Standby Power Generation System Upgrade Project were Non-Responsive, and Reject All Bids; Determine that Further Bidding on the Supply Agreement Would Not Produce an Advantage to the Public; and Direct District Staff to Negotiate an Acceptable Supply Agreement in the Best Interests of the District Starting with Apparent Low Bidder, Cummins Sales and Service, and if an Acceptable Agreement Cannot be Obtained with Cummins, Third Apparent Low Bidder, Peterson Power Systems, Inc. If District Staff is Unable to Negotiate an Acceptable Supply Agreement with either Cummings or Peterson Power, Staff Should Take Such Further Actions as are Permitted by Law. #### **INFORMATION ITEMS:**

#### **Status of Priority 1 Capital Improvement Program Projects**

This item was reviewed by the Engineering and Information Technology Committee. Technical Services Manager Ghossain stated the Board approved the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget of \$19.73 million for design and construction of 24 CIP projects in June of 2019. The projects were ranked Priority 1, 2, or 3 based upon criteria prepared by staff and approved by the Executive Team. There were 11 projects ranked as Priority 1 for Fiscal Year 2020. The status of Priority 1 CIP projects is reviewed by the Executive Team at the end of each quarter and a copy of the status report was included in the Board meeting packet.

#### Fourth Quarterly Report on the Capital Improvement Program for FY20

This item was reviewed by the Engineering and Information Technology Committee. Technical Services Manager Ghossain stated fourth quarter expenditures for Fiscal Year 2020 were presented in graphs included in the Board meeting packet. The graphs depicted actual expenditures versus approved budget for Capacity Fund 900, the Renewal and Replacement Fund 800, and for both funds combined. Total CIP expenditures up to June 30, 2020, were under projections for the fourth quarter by

approximately \$6.8 million. Projects that had significant variances from projected expenditures were presented in a table included in the Board meeting packet.

#### Report on the East Bay Dischargers Authority Meeting of August 20, 2020

General Manager Eldredge provided an overview of the EBDA Commission meeting minutes included in the Board meeting packet.

#### **COVID-19 Update**

General Manager Eldredge provided an update regarding COVID-19 impacts on District operations and association coordinated efforts.

#### **Check Register**

Staff responded to Boardmember questions regarding the check register.

#### **COMMITTEE MEETING REPORTS:**

The Legal/Community Affairs and Engineering and Information Technology met.

#### **GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT:**

General Manager Eldredge stated the following:

- The Board will receive a packet of materials in advance of the two upcoming General Manager's Evaluation Closed Sessions.
- Of the 27 bills the District had been monitoring, seven made it to the Governor's desk for consideration. Staff will send a summary of those seven bills to the Board via email.

Director Toy stated she attended the Alameda County Special District's Association meeting and further stated the next meeting will be held October 18, 2020.
